The **MISSION** of the Clinton Community School District is to educate all students to their highest level of achievement through an engaging curriculum in a caring community.

LEARNING

- On the Iowa Fast Reading Assessment from September 2016 to June 2017, 100% of Clinton students in grades two and three will demonstrate one of the following markers: proficiency on the assessment or reach or exceed the IEP goal as defined by their IEP team.
- The Clinton High School Graduation rate will increase to 100%.

FINANCE & FACILITIES

- The school board will prioritize a plan for capital improvements in allocation of district funding mechanisms.
- The general cash balance will increase to 5.0%.
- The board will continue to actively advocate and support the extension of the statewide penny sales tax through the repeal of the Dec. 31, 2029 sunset.
- The district will research and work towards a long-term plan of non-discrimination as it applies to the Affordable Health Care Act (insurance benefits).

HUMAN RESOURCES

- The board will remain committed to an action plan for greater marketing of the school district with educational stake-holders (students, parents, staff, and community members).

BOARD DEVELOPMENT:

- Engage, as a board and individuals, continuous development in gaining greater capacity as a school board member.
