

USE OF MOTOR VEHICLES

The board recognizes the convenience to families and students of having students drive to and park at and around Clinton High School. Driving a motor vehicle to and parking it at Clinton High School is a privilege.

Students who drive to and park at either high school shall only drive to and park at in designed parking areas. Students shall enter and leave designed parking areas by the routes designated by the principal. Students may not loiter around or be in their vehicle during the school day without permission from the principal. Failure to comply with this policy or established parking rules, or found to driving in reckless manner while on school property shall be reason for revocation of school driving and parking privileges as well as other disciplinary action including suspension and expulsion.

Students who live within one mile of school, and would not otherwise be eligible for a student driving permit, may be eligible for a student driving permit, for driving to and from school and school activities and practices, if the student is participating in a co-curricular activity either before or after school hours.
